

Dedicated EU funding for the bioeconomy under the EU R&D Framework Programme has more than doubled; from EUR 1.9 billion in FP7 to EUR 4.52 billion in Horizon2020.

The strong investment in bioeconomy related R&I is already generating relevant multi-disciplinary and cross-sectoral scientific knowledge and promising technologies and innovations are emerging.

Substantial private funding has also been mobilised through the Bio-Based Industries Joint Undertaking (BBI JU), a public private partnership which is leveraging EUR 2.7 billion of private investment through EUR 1 billion EU investment.

The BBI-JU aims to establish a European bio-based industry sector that creates new markets and value chains, and that develops advanced and sustainable bio-based products, technologies, materials and biofuels from renewable natural resources from land and sea, waste and industrial side-streams.
